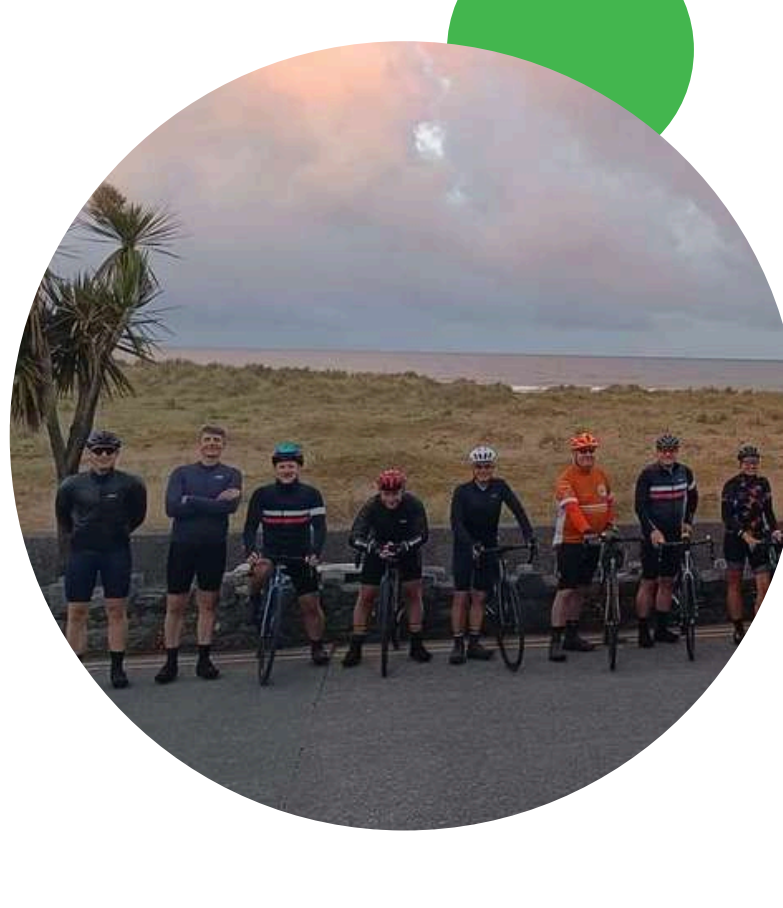
CAFT CREW JUMP OUT OF A PLANE!
